20	of the same design and color as the plates issued un-		
21	der section 131. The fee for these plates shall be		
22	the same as the fee for plates issued under section		
23	132. Individuals desiring to retain their same num-		
24	ber or numbers presently assigned on January 1, 1988,

In addition, it is anticipated that the bill will require a highway fund allocation of \$792,573 for fiscal year 1987-88 and \$67,269 for fiscal year 1988-89 to the Division of Motor Vehicle to provide funds for personnel and general overall expenses to manufacture the proposed "lobsterless plates," as well as projected costs for the purchase of required reflective sheeting and aluminum to manufacture the plates.'
