lien holder shall retain such watch, clock, 14 The jewelry, clothes, electric motor, major and traffic 15 appliance, small gasoline motor, radio and other 16 electronic equipment and musical instrument for a pe-17 18 riod of 6 months, at the expiration of which time, if 19 such lien is not satisfied, he may sell such watch, 20 jewelry, clothes, electric motor, major and clock, traffic appliance, small gasoline motor, radio and 21 22 other electronic equipment and musical instrument at 23 public or private sale, after giving 30 days' notice 24 in writing to the owner, specifying the amount due, describing the property to be sold and informing him 25 the payment of such amount within 30 days shall 26 that 27 entitle him to redeem such property. Such notice may 28 be given by mailing the same addressed to the owner's place of residence if known, or if the owner's place 29 30 of residence is unknown, a copy of such notice may be posted by the holder of such lien in 2 public places 31 32 in the town, village or city where the property is 33 held.
