20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	2 MRSA §1-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 801, §§1 and 7, is amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28	1. Terms and conditions. Any former Governor and any surviving spouse of a deceased Governor or former Governor is entitled, upon application and upon reaching age 65 60, to a retirement allowance under the following terms and conditions.
29 30 31 32	A. The amount of the retirement allowance is 3/8 of the annual salary being paid the current Gov- ernor on the date the retirement allowance be- comes effective.

1 B. A surviving spouse of a deceased Governor or 2 former Governor is entitled to receive the allow-3 ance beginning the day after the death of the 4 Governor or former Governor.

5 C. Any person who succeeds to the office of Gov-6 ernor by means other than by election must serve 7 as Governor a minimum of 6 months to qualify him-8 self or a surviving spouse for the retirement al-9 lowance.

10D. Whatever adjustments are made under Title 5,11sections 17806 and 18407 shall be applied to pay-12ments made under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to change from 65 to 15 60 the age at which a former Governor becomes eligi-16 ble for a retirement allowance.
