17 AN ACT to Reduce the Retirement Age
18 Requirement for Governors.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 2 MRSA §1-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
23 801, §§1 and 7, is amended to read:

24 1. Terms and conditions. Any former Governor and
25 any surviving spouse of a deceased Governor or former
26 Governor is entitled, upon application and upon
27 reaching age 65 60, to a retirement allowance under
28 the following terms and conditions.

29 A. The amount of the retirement allowance is 3/8
30 of the annual salary being paid the current Gov-
31 ernor on the date the retirement allowance be-
32 comes effective.

1 B. A surviving spouse of a deceased Governor or
2 former Governor is entitled to receive the allow-
3 ance beginning the day after the death of the
4 Governor or former Governor.

5 C. Any person who succeeds to the office of Gov-
6 ernor by means other than by election must serve
7 as Governor a minimum of 6 months to qualify him-
8 self or a surviving spouse for the retirement al-
9 lowance.

10 D. Whatever adjustments are made under Title 5,
11 sections 17806 and 18407 shall be applied to pay-
12 ments made under this section.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to change from 65 to
15 60 the age at which a former Governor becomes eligi-
16 ble for a retirement allowance.
