17 AN ACT to Change the Membership on the Board  
18 of Chiropractic Examination and  
19 Registration.  
20

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 § 2 MRSA §501, as amended by PL 1983, c. 812,  
24 §198, is further amended to read:

25 The Board of Chiropractic Examination and Regis-  
26 tration, as established by Title 5, section 12004,  
27 subsection 1, and in this chapter called the "board,"  
28 shall consist of 6 7 persons, who shall be appointed  
29 by the Governor. Said persons shall be residents of  
30 this State, 5 shall be graduates of a legally  
31 chartered chiropractic school, college or university  
32 having the power to confer degrees in chiropractic

1 and shall have been at the time of their appointment  
2 actively engaged in the practice of their profession  
3 for a period of at least 3 years in this State and  
4 one 2 shall be a representative representatives of  
5 the public. A public member may not have been a chi-  
6 ropractic doctor or have been an immediate family  
7 member of a chiropractic doctor. Each appointment  
8 shall be for the period of 5 years as the terms of  
9 the present members expire. Any vacancy in said board  
10 caused by death, resignation or for any other cause,  
11 except completion of a full term of service, shall be  
12 filled by the like appointment of a person qualified  
13 as aforesaid to hold office during the unexpired term  
14 of the member whose place he fills. Any member of  
15 said board may be removed from office for cause by  
16 the Governor.

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill changes the membership on the Board of  
19 Chiropractic Examination and Registration by adding  
20 an additional public member and by adding the re-  
21 quirement that a public member may not be affiliated  
22 with a chiropractic doctor.

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
