21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

A panel of mediators, to consist of not less 2 than 5 nor more than 10 impartial members, 3 appointed by the Governor from time to time 4 upon the expiration of the terms of the several 5 members, for terms of 3 years. They shall be cho-6 by the Governor from a list, containing at 7 least 5 times as many names as the number of persons to be chosen, supplied at least once a 8 by the Maine Labor Relations Board. Vacancies oc-9 10 curring during a term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Any costs for ser-24 vices rendered and expenses incurred by the panel 25 of mediators beyond the 3rd mediation day per case shall be shared equally by the parties to the proceedings, except that on a showing by ei-26 27 28 ther party that such the payment would impose un-29 due financial hardship, the executive director 30 may waive all or part of such the obligation. amount waived shall be paid from the 31 The 32 above-mentioned appropriation. Authorization for 33 services rendered and expenditures incurred by members of the panel shall be the responsibility 34 35 of the Executive Director of the Maine Labor Relations Board. 36

The members of the panel of mediators are custom-
arily the threshold persons whose conciliation and
labor relations expertise are requested to bring
about amicable settlement of contract negotiations
disputes between the parties through conference or
other peaceful means when the parties have been un-
able to reach agreement on the terms of a contract.
The daily rate of pay for the members of the panel of
mediators has not been increased since 1973. This
legislation will increase the daily rate of pay for
mediators from \$75 a day to \$125 a day. This legis-
lation should retain and attract qualified persons to
serve on the panel of mediators and should more fair-
ly compensate members of the panel of mediators for
services rendered. The estimated cost of this bill
