COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 69, L.D. 72

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that all vehicles engaged in snow plowing and sanding for public entities are exempt from the truck weight limits. Those vehicles would be exempt from axle and tire size limits at all times. This exemption is necessary as the modification for snowplows results in these trucks usually violating one or more limits even when no plow is on the truck.
