This bill seeks to exempt those municipal vehicles involved in both snow removal and road maintenance from the weight restrictions imposed on commercial vehicles. It recognizes and validates the practice, common throughout the State, of using municipal dump trucks for the twofold purpose of snowplowing and gravel hauling in the wintertime.

9 Besides being a public safety measure designed to 10 keep the roads in good conditions, the practice of 11 relying on a single vehicle to perform dual functions is also a cost-effective one. It relieves a munici-12 13 pality from having either to maintain 2 separate 14 fleets of trucks, or to attach or take of the snowplow equipment as the situation demands. latter option is as impractical as the first, in light of the fact that it takes the best part of a workday to remove or install the snowplow and its attachments.

Since the weight restrictions and penalty system were imposed, numerous municipalities have incurred substantial fines for operating overweight combination snowplows and dump trucks on state highways. This bill recognizes that those municipal vehicles which are performing valuable public safety functions should be exempted from strict compliance legislated weight limits.
