COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 72, L.D. 75,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Complimentary Archery Li-
censes to Residents Over 70 Years of Age."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title
(page 1, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) and inserting in its
place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide Complimentary Archery Licenses
and Muzzle-loading Hunting Licenses to Residents Over
70 Years of Age.'

Further amend the Bill in the first line after
the enacting clause (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by add-
ing the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill in subsection 1 in the 3rd
line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the
following: "section 7102," the following: 'and a
muzzle-loading hunting license under section 7107-A,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7102, sub-§6, as enacted by PL
1985, c. 91, §2 is repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment adds the muzzle-loading hunting
3 license to the licenses that residents over 70 years
4 of age can receive for free. It also repeals the
5 sunset for the provision that allows archery hunters
6 to carry handguns while hunting during the special
7 archery season. Without this amendment, this provi-
8 sion will sunset on October 1, 1987.
