17 AN ACT to Provide Complimentary Archery
18 Licenses to Residents Over 70 Years of
19 Age.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1983, c.
24 797, §3, is further amended to read:

25 1. Residents over 70 years of age. A complimen-
26 tary license to hunt, trap or fish, including an
27 archery license under section 7102, shall be issued
28 to any resident of Maine who is 70 years of age or
29 older and applies for it to the commissioner. The ap-
30 plication shall be accompanied by a birth certificate
31 or other certified evidence of the applicant's date
32 of birth and residency. Each license issued under
33 this subsection shall remain valid through December

1 31st of the 2nd complete calendar year following the
2 year of issuance.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This bill provides that residents over 70 years
5 of age may receive complimentary archery licenses as
6 they may already have for hunting, fishing and trap-
7 ping.
