20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	22 MRSA §1579, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 239, is amended to read:
24 25	§1579. Free distribution of cigarettes to children under the age of 18 years
26 27 28 29 30 31 32	1. Prohibition. No person may knowingly sell; furnish, give away or offer to sell; furnish or give away cigarettes or tobacco to any child under the age of 18 years. No person in the business of selling or otherwise distributing cigarettes or other tobacco products for profit, or an employee or agent of such a person, may, in the course of his business, dis-

1	tribute any cigarette or other tobacco product free
2	to any children under the age of 18 years in any
3	place, including, but not limited to, a public way or
4	sidewalk, public park or playground, public school
5	or other public building, or an entranceway, lobby,
6	hall or other common area of a private building,
7	shopping center or mall.

8 2. <u>Penalty.</u> Violation of this section shall re-9 sult in a fine of not less than \$20 nor more than \$50 10 for each violation.

## 11 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the law regarding the sale of cigarettes to children. This bill removes the reference to the sale of cigarettes in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1579, leaving the sale of cigarettes to a child under the age of 16 as a Class D crime under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 554.
