17 AN ACT Relating to Building Inspections.  
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
20 follows:

21 Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2355 is repealed.

22 Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2359, as amended by PL 1975, c.  
23 623, §35, is further amended to read:

24 §2359. Refusing admission to inspector

25 Any owner or occupant of a building, who refuses  
26 to permit an inspector of buildings to enter his  
27 buildings or willfully obstructs him in the inspec-  
28 tion of such building as required by chapters 313 to  
29 321, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1  
30 \$50 nor more than ~~\$20~~ \$250, to be recovered by com-  
31 plaint or indictment.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill repeals a law that has outlived its  
3 usefulness. To require, as the Maine Revised Stat-  
4 utes, Title 25, section 2355 does, the inspector of  
5 buildings to examine all the heating apparatus "in  
6 all the buildings within his jurisdiction" is unrea-  
7 sonable and unnecessary. If the need or desire to  
8 conduct such an inspection should arise, a municipal-  
9 ity may always authorize it by ordinance.

10 The bill increases the fine structure for the of-  
11 fense of refusing entry to a building inspector so as  
12 to comport with modern penalty levels. The original  
13 law has never been amended in this regard and needs  
14 to be.

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
