17 AN ACT Relating to Fencing of Swimming Pools.
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19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 22 MRSA §1631, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
22 436, is amended to read:

23 2. Swimming pool "Swimming pool" means an out-
24 door body of water enclosed in an artificial recepta-
25 cle or other container, whether in or above the
26 ground, used or intended to be used to contain water
27 for swimming or bathing and designed for a water
28 depth of 24 inches or more.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the definition of swimming pool so that pools which do not have water in them are still subject to the fencing requirement.

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
