17 AN ACT to Permit Spouses of Prisoners of War
18 Special License Plate Privileges.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §252-E, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1985,
23 c. 737, Pt. A, §80, is amended to read:

24 §252-E. Former prisoners of war; special license
25 plates

26 The Secretary of State, on application and upon
27 evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Title
28 36, section 1482, shall issue a registration certificate
29 and set of special designating plates to be
30 used in lieu of regular registration plates to any
31 person who served in the United States Armed Forces
32 and who was a prisoner of war at any time during his

1 tenure of service, or the wife or widow of such a
2 person, when that application is accompanied by a
3 copy of the appropriate military form certifying that
4 the person is a former prisoner of war. This special
5 license plate is issued specifically to former pris-
6 oners of war and the privilege of using the special
7 plate is ~~not~~ transferable only to the former
8 prisoner's spouse.

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

10 This bill shall extend the privileges of special
11 license plates to the wives and widows of former
12 prisoners of war.
