AN ACT to Reduce the Fee for a Trapper's  
License for Servicemen Stationed in  
the State.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

12 MRSA §7133, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Armed Forces domiciled in the State. A trap-  
ping license shall be issued upon payment of \$16,  
plus the issuing fee, to any person on active duty in  
the Armed Forces of the United States who is perma-  
nently stationed in the State.
