Amend the bill by striking out all of subsection  
5 (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) and insert in its  
place the following:

'5. Penalty. A violation of this section is a  
Class E crime which, notwithstanding Title 17-A, sec-  
tion 1301, is punishable by a \$250 minimum fine for  
the first offense and a mandatory 30-day suspension  
of a driver's license for a 2nd offense occurring  
within 3 years of the first offense.'

This amendment keeps the present classification  
of the offense as a Class E crime. It sets a \$250  
minimum for the first offense and a 30-day suspension  
of the driver's license for a 2nd offense which oc-  
curs within 3 years.
