20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	22 MRSA §5109, first and 3rd ¶¶, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 630, §1, are amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	Members of the committee shall be citizens of the State who have an unselfish and demonstrated interest in older people, a knowledge of the status of surviv- al common to Maine's elderly, and an unwavering alle- giance to the challenge of the declaration of a peo- ple made by older Americans. At least 2 members of the committee shall be current members of the Legis- lature, one from the House of Representatives who shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one from the Senate who shall be

1 appointed by the President of the Senate. Thirteen members shall be citizens who are current leaders of 2 3 Maine's elderly from a number of fields such as income, health, housing and community and social ser-4 5 vices and who have proven experience in private, pub-6 lic and voluntary organizations on the state, regional and community level such as state-wide membership 7 8 task forces on aging, regional and county groups, 9 councils of older people, and municipal level senior 10 citizens clubs.

11 Legislative members shall serve during their legislative terms. Members The other members shall be 12 13 appointed for a term terms of 3 years, except that of 14 the members first appointed, 5 shall be appointed for a term of one year, 5 shall be appointed for a term 15 of 2 years and 5 shall be appointed for a term of 3 16 17 years, as designated by the Governor at the time ef 18 appointment; and except that any. Any member ap-19 pointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term for which his predecessor was 20 21 appointed shall be appointed only for the remainder 22 of such that term.

STATEMENT OF FACT

24 The purpose of this bill is to provide that the 25 legislative members of the Maine Committee on Aging 26 be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Represen-27 tatives and the President of the Senate rather than 28 by the Governor.
