17 AN ACT Pertaining to Signing of Nomination
18 Petitions.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 21-A MRSA §354, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
23 161, §6, is amended to read:

24 2. By whom signed. A nomination petition may be
25 signed only by unenrolled voters of the electoral di-
26 vision which is to make the nomination, except that
27 nomination petitions for presidential electors may be
28 signed by any unenrolled Maine voter. Other
29 signatures are void.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to allow only
3 unenrolled but registered voters to sign nomination
4 petitions for candidates seeking nomination by peti-
5 tion rather than through a party procedure.

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
