17 AN ACT to Permit Judges of the United States
18 to be Admitted to the Practice of Law
19 in Maine by Motion.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 4 MRSA §802-A is enacted to read:

24 §802-A. Judges of the United States

25 Judges of the United States appointed to a court
26 or administrative agency of the United States and
27 performing their duties in this State, in a United
28 States court or a United States administrative agency
29 office may be admitted to the general practice of law
30 in this State upon motion in the Supreme Judicial
31 Court without complying with section 805-A.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit federal
3 judges assigned to federal courts or administrative
4 agencies in Maine to gain admission to the Maine bar
5 without having to take an admission examination or
6 meet the other requirements generally applied to can-
7 didates for admission to the practice of law in
8 Maine.

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
