The state board may approve projects so long as no project approval will cause debt service costs, as defined in section 15603, subsection 8, paragraphs A and D, to exceed \$35,000,000 in a subsequent fiscal year. The state board may increase the limit by 10% to take into account increased requests for projects deemed necessary by the state board because of the unusually heavy local demand for high priority school construction. This paragraph shall take effect on July 1, 1986.
