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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 116, L.D. 141,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Concerning Extension  
of Motor Vehicle Registration Expiration Dates."

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Amend the Bill by inserting after the title and  
before the enacting clause the following:

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'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the Secretary of State has determined  
that this legislative measure is necessary to curb  
abuse of tardy renewals of automobile registrations;  
and

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Whereas, timely observance of the State's regis-  
tration requirements is required to ensure full com-  
pliance with the responsibilities involved in operat-  
ing a motor vehicle in the State; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore, '

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Further amend the Bill by inserting before the  
statement of fact the following:

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'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency  
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect  
when approved.'
