COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 117, L.D. 142, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Employment Security Law Regarding Full-time Students in the Employ of Organized Camps to Conform with the Federal Unemployment Tax Act."

Amend the Bill in section 2, in subsection 30, in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 9, lines 31 and 32 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "is a student for any period"

Further amend the Bill in section 2, in subsection 30 in the 5th line (page 9, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "During which the individual is" and inserting in their place the following: 'Is'

Further amend the Bill in section 2, in subsection 30 in the 8th line (page 9, line 36 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "Which is" and inserting in their place the following: 'Is'

This amendment clarifies language used in the definition of "full-time student."
