21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23 24 25	20-A MRSA §13402, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983, c. 520, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

A substitute teacher shall be compensated for each day of service at a rate of not less than an amount determined by multi- plying the base or minimum salary paid to a teacher employed in the administrative unit where the substi- tute teacher is employed by a fraction, the numerator of which is one and the denominator of which is the total number of days in the school year within that school administrative unit.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to increase the mini-3 mum compensation for substitute teachers and to tie 4 that compensation to the base salary paid to teachers 5 in local school administrative units.

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
