17 AN ACT to Provide Adequate Compensation for
18 Substitute Teachers and to Take into
19 Account Local Ability to Pay.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 20-A MRSA §13402, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983,
24 c. 520, is repealed and the following enacted in its
25 place:

26 3. Substitute teachers. A substitute teacher
27 shall be compensated for each day of service at a
28 rate of not less than an amount determined by multi-
29 plying the base or minimum salary paid to a teacher
30 employed in the administrative unit where the substi-
31 tute teacher is employed by a fraction, the numerator
32 of which is one and the denominator of which is the
33 total number of days in the school year within that
34 school administrative unit.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to increase the mini-
3 mum compensation for substitute teachers and to tie
4 that compensation to the base salary paid to teachers
5 in local school administrative units.

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
