25 26 27	8. <u>Restrictions.</u> Guides shall be restricted in the use of watercraft while guiding on such waters as the commissioner may prescribe.
28 29 30 31 32 33	The commissioner may establish, by rule, standards for the use by a guide, of watercraft other than a motorboat, to insure that the watercraft is safe for the use intended, that sufficient safety equipment is provided to each passenger and the operator is competent to use the watercraft.
