Amend the resolve in the 9th paragraph after the title by striking out the first sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'Resolved: That at the earliest possible time a building of prestige and dignity which is compatible with the Capitol and Capitol Park shall be constructed within the City of Augusta.'

17 Further amend the resolve by striking out the 10th 18 paragraph after the title and inserting in its place 19 the following:

20 'Project program; planning. Resolved: That work on a project program for the construction of a 21 22 Supreme Judicial Court in Augusta shall be initiated as soon as possible after the passage of this resolve 23 24 by a nationally recognized court planner. This planner shall be required to have available in 25 sufficient time to be included in legislation 26 presented to the First Regular Session of the 114th 27 Legislature a cost estimate of sufficient accuracy as to be suitable for a request for funding to cover completely all aspects of the construction of this court facility including adequate parking facilities; 28 29 30 31 and be it further' 32

Present to the First Regular Session of the 17 114th Legislature a report containing a 18 recommendation on a site within the City of Augusta for the proposed court facility and the construction cost estimate of the court planner. The report shall include legislation necessary to fund construction of the court facility through a bond issue approved by voter referendum and to request a General Fund appropriation for a court 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 facility design competition; and'

Further amend the resolve in the 2nd appropriation by striking out the 4th line (page 6, line 2 in L.D.) "1986-87" and inserting in its place the following: '1988-89'

### 'FISCAL NOTE

2 Enactment of this resolve will require a General Fund appropriation of \$140,000 in fiscal year 1989 to 3 4 fund the activities of a court planner and the Supreme 5 Judicial Court Plan and Design Commission. A bond issue to fund the construction of a court facility will be presented to the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature. A General Fund appropriation for fiscal year 1990, estimated at \$200,000, will be 6 7 8 9 requested to fund a court facility design competition. Expenditures from this appropriation 10 11 12 only if the voters ratified would occur the 13 construction bond issue.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes language that would have sited a new Supreme Judicial Court facility only at the far end of state-owned Capitol Park. It replaces that language by calling for the proposed court facility to be located within the City of Augusta. A proposed commission will report to the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature with a recommendation on a final site, with a bond issue to finance the construction of a facility and a request to fund a court facility design competition.
