COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 81, L.D. 167

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear 3 that the site location decisions being delegated to the Commissioner of Environmental Protection are only 4 a 50% or smaller expansion of a facility, which 5 6 facility has been previously approved under the site 7 location laws. The amendment also deletes the sec-8 tions of the bill which would delegate authority to 9 the commissioner over freshwater wetland permits. 10 The committee feels that this action is premature since the department has yet to promulgate rules gov-11 12 erning this type of permit. Thus, every freshwater 13 wetlands permit is potentially precedent setting. The amendment deletes a separate section of the bill 14 which is unnecessary and could be read in conflict 15 16 with existing law.
