IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Requirements for a Master Electrician License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §1202, sub-§1, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 734, is amended to read:

B. For a master electrician's license, a person must:

(1) Complete at least 4,000 hours of service as a journeyman electrician or at least 12,000 hours of experience in electrical installations, as defined in section 1101; complete a program of study comprising 576 hours as approved by the Electricians! Exam-

1 ining Beard and complete a course e£ net 2 less than 45 hours in the current National 3 Electrical Code, the course to be approved by the Electricians! Examining Board. 4 Any person who holds a 5 journeyman electrician's or limited license under this б section or under former section 1202, sub-section 1, shall be eligible to take the ex-7 8 9 amination for a master electrician's license, provided that the applicant has com-10 pleted the number of hours of service or ex-11 perience required by this subsection. 12

## STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The purpose of this bill is to amend the require-15 ments for a master electrician license by removing 16 the 2 course requirements. Under this bill, to qual-17 ify for a master electrician license, the applicant 18 must still complete his hours of service as a jour-19 neyman and in electrical installation and successful-20 ly take the examination.
