AN ACT Relating to Requirements for a Master
Electrician License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §1202, sub-§1, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 734, is amended to read:

B. For a master electrician's license, a person must:

(1) Complete at least 4,000 hours of service as a journeyman electrician or at least 12,000 hours of experience in electrical installations, as defined in section 1101, complete a program of study comprising 576 hours as approved by the Electricians' Exam-
