COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 135, L.D. 176,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Law Concerning Handicapped
Motor Vehicle Registrations."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the
following:

'Sec. 3. 29 MRSA §252, last ¶, as enacted by PL
1975, c. 16, §4, is amended to read:

These special designating plates placards shall
bear the International Handicap Symbol, ~~easily-recog-
nizable-at-a-distance, which-indicates-that-the-vehi-
cle-is-owned-by-a-handicapped-person.~~'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by adding before the
statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an increase in Highway
Fund revenue to the Office of Secretary of State, Di-
vision of Motor Vehicle, of approximately \$8,200 an-
nually. This estimate is based on the proposed re-
quirement of a \$1 fee charged to an anticipated 8,200
handicapped motor vehicle registrants for the issu-
ance of a special designated placard.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment allows this paragraph to coincide
3 with the change in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
4 29, section 252, first paragraph, which eliminates
