23 24 25 26 27 28 29	This bill will result in an increase in Highway Fund revenue to the Office of Secretary of State, Division of Motor Vehicle, of approximately \$8,200 annually. This estimate is based on the proposed requirement of a \$1 fee charged to an anticipated 8,200 handicapped motor vehicle registrants for the issuance of a special designated placard.'
