IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD

AN ACT Concerning the Payment and State  
Reimbursement to Boarding Care  
Facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

22 MRSA §7907, as repealed by replaced by PL  
1985, c. 791, §1, is repealed and the following en-  
acted in its place:

§7907. Boarding care payments

The department shall reimburse those boarding  
care facilities subject to reimbursement at a flat  
rate not to exceed \$650 per resident per month and  
those boarding care facilities subject to reasonable  
cost reimbursement at a rate not to exceed \$650 per  
resident per month.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill revises the payment system followed by the Department of Human Services for compensating operators of boarding care facilities by increasing the amount of compensation to be paid by the department.

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
