1 2 3	AN ACT Concerning the Definition of Resident under the Fisheries and Wildlife Laws.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7	12 MRSA §7001, sub-§32, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:
8 9 .0	C. If owning a motor vehicle or vehicles located within the State, registered each such at least one vehicle in Maine; and

2 This bill amends the law dealing with the definition of "resident" under the fisheries and wildlife 3 4 laws. Currently, if a person has more than one motor 5: vehicle in the State, he must register each of those vehicles in Maine. A number of people are legal residents of Maine, pay taxes here, own property here and vote here, but winter outside of the State. If they have a 2nd vehicle which is registered outside 7 9 of the State and which they bring back to Maine, they 11 are not considered residents under the fisheries and 12 wildlife laws.

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
