1 AN ACT Relating to the Definition of Resident
2 under the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Laws.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§32, ¶C, as enacted by PL
7 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

8 C. If owning a motor vehicle or vehicles located
9 within the State, registered each such vehicle in
10 Maine. This paragraph does not apply to any per-
11 son who is on active duty in the United States
12 Armed Forces; and

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill exempts persons on active duty in the Armed Forces from the requirement that they register their motor vehicles in the State in order to be considered residents under the fisheries and wildlife laws.

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
