under the Highway Laws.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §3021, sub-§§2-A and 2-B are en-  
7 acted to read:

8 2-A. Reasonable passage. "Reasonable passage"  
9 means the traveled way is at least 14 feet in width  
10 and permits safe and convenient operation of vehicles  
11 traveling at 15 miles per hour.

12 2-B. Seasonal way. "Seasonal way" means an area  
13 or strip of land designated and held by a municipali-  
14 ty for the passage and use of the general public by  
15 motor vehicles between May 15th and October 1st of  
16 each calendar year.
