SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 150, L.D. 191, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Cer-
tain Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend the amendment in section 3 by striking out
everything after the amending clause and inserting in
its place the following:

'Any person, partnership or corporation, owning
or leasing and applying for registration of a semi-
trailer or trailer, may make application upon a blank
supplied by the Secretary of State for a semiperman-
ent registration plate to be displayed on the rear
of the semitrailer or trailer so owned or leased. The
persons, partnerships or corporations must be Maine
residents or if they are not, must have a place of
business and an address in Maine ~~and must operate and~~
~~register a truck tractor in the State of Maine~~ or a
designated agent or representative resident in Maine.
The Secretary of State shall furnish the person,
partnership or corporation with one semipermanent
plate for each such semitrailer or trailer, which
plate shall expire either at the end of each 8-year
or 12-year semipermanent plate program or, in the
case of new semitrailers or new trailers, at the end
of the 12th registration year following the year of
issuance, depending upon the type of registration re-
quested by the applicant. The fee shall be ~~\$10~~ \$15
for each semitrailer registration and ~~\$5~~ \$7.50 for
each trailer registration for not more than 2,000
pounds, GVW, for each registration year, or portion
thereof; and there shall be no refund of payment of
such fee, except that when a plate is returned within
120 days of the effective date of that year's regis-
tration with an affidavit that the plate has never
been used and the Secretary of State is satisfied
that the plate has never been used, the pro rata

1 amount, based upon the unused portion of the semiper-
2 manent plate period at the time of surrender of the
3 registration, shall be refunded. Any trailer regis-
4 tered for more than 2,000 pounds shall pay the annual
5 registration fee as set forth in section 244.'

6 Further amend the amendment by inserting before
7 the statement of fact the following:

8 'Amend the Bill by inserting before the statement
9 of fact the following


10 'Fiscal Note

11 This bill will result in an increase in Highway
12 Fund revenue of approximately \$4,000,000 in fiscal
13 year 1987-88 and \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 1988-89.
14 This increase will be derived from the proposed in-
15 cremental increase in the long-term trailer registra-
16 tion fee.'
