Resolve, Concerning State Government Reorganization.

Commission to study State Government reorganiza-That there is established the Comtion. Resolved: mission on State Government Reorganization. The commission shall consist of the following members: One Senator, who is a member of the majority political party in the Senate and a member of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government or the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, appointed by the President of the Senate; one Senator, who is a member of the minority political party in the Senate and a member of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government or the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, appointed by the Senate Minority Leader; one member of the House of Representatives,

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who is a member of the majority political party 1 in 2 of Representatives and a member of the the House 3 Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government or the Joint Standing Committee on Appropria-4 5 tions and Financial Affairs, appointed by the Speaker 6 of the House of Representatives; one member of the 7 of Representatives, who is a member of the mi-House 8 nority political party in the House of Representatives and a member of the Joint Standing Committee on 9 10 State and Local Government or the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, ap-11 12 pointed by the House Minority Leader; 2 state career 13 employees appointed by the Governor; 8 members from 14 private business appointed by the Governor from among 15 names submitted to the Governor by business organiza-16 tions throughout the State; and be it further

Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall investigate possible integration or elimination of state programs, departments and agencies, including, but not limited to, the elimination of duplication in services and programs; and be it further

22 Report. Resolved: That the commission shall re-23 port its findings, together with any implementing 24 legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 25 ll3th Legislature; and be it further

26 Compensation. Resolved: That the members of the 27 commission shall not receive compensation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

29 The purpose of this resolve is to establish a 30 commission to study possible integration or elimina-31 tion of state programs, departments and agencies.

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
