AN ACT Requiring Proper Placement of Motor

2 3	Vehicle Dealer Plates.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7 8	29 MRSA §381, as amended by PL 1983, c. 818, §11, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
9	Notwithstanding this section, each dealer regis-
10	tration plate shall be displayed at an angle of not
11	less than 45 degrees from the ground and visible from
12	the rear of the vehicle. Any dealer who violates this
13	paragraph commits a civil violation for which a for-
14	feiture of not more than \$500 may be adjudged.

The purpose of this bill is to require that dealer license plates be displayed at not less than a 45 degree angle from the ground. Violation is punishable by a forfeiture of not more than \$500.
