STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Regarding the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

7 Whereas, there are several members of the Maine
8 Land Use Regulation Commission serving beyond their
9 statutory terms; and

10 Whereas, the commission is facing many important 11 issues and requires a full contingent of members who 12 are not in this situation; and

13 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 14 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

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1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §683, as amended by PL 1985, c.
345, is further amended by adding at the end a new
paragraph to read:

10 Any member who has not been renominated by the Governor within 90 days of the expiration of his term 11 12 shall not continue to serve on the commission, unless 13 the Governor notifies the Legislature in writing and 14 within 90 days of the expiration of that member's 15 term of his finding that extension of that member's 16 term is required to ensure fair consideration of specific major applications pending before the commis-17 18 That member's term shall end upon final sion. com-19 mission decisions on the specific applications identified in the Governor's communication. 20 A vacancy during an unexpired term shall be filled as provided 21 in this section, but only for the unexpired portion 22 23 of the term.

24 Sec. 2. Application. The provisions of this Act 25 apply to all future members of the Maine Land shall 26 Use Regulation Commission. It is the intent of the 27 Legislature that any current members of the commis-28 sion whose terms expired before the effective date of 29 this Act shall not continue to serve on the commission, unless the Governor exercises his authority un-30 31 der the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 683, within 90 days of the effective date of this Act. 32 33

34 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 35 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-36 proved.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to make provisions governing the treatment of commission members whose terms have expired parallel to the provisions governing the Board of Environmental Protection. It is the intent of the Legislature that, for these important policy-making positions, the Governor promptly renominate or replace commission members so as to avoid uncertainty in the administration of important state agencies.

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
