4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

Sec. 1. Establishment of a fund. There is established a fund entitled "Stripper Well Fund" within the Office of Energy Resources. Any funds received by the State from the Federal Government relating to the stripper well oil overcharge case shall be deposited to the fund. Interest accruing on these funds shall be deposited to the fund to be used for the same purposes.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the Stripper Well Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

27 The purpose of this bill is to provide for money 28 to allow an extension of the Homeowner Weatherization 29 Program. The original program provided funds to re-30 homeowners for 50% of the imburse cost of 31 weatherization materials. This program has been suc-32 cessful and warrants continuation. Funds to extend the rebate program will be derived from the settle-ment of 2 "over-charge cases." The money is current-ly named "Stripper Well Fund" and in escrow account 33 34 35 at the Attorney General's Office. 36
