nursing homes, as defined in section 1812-A, shall

have at least \$30 \$45 a month for personal needs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

1.

The purpose of this bill is to increase the so-
called personal needs allowance for Supplemental Se-
curity Income recipients who are residents of nursing
homes. In 1980, the Legislature enacted a statutory
provision requiring that the personal needs allowance
for nursing home residents be at least \$30 a month.
Since 1981, regulations of the Department of Human
Services call for a personal needs allowance for
nursing home residents of \$35 a month. This bill pro-
vides a modest increase of \$10 a month.

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
