IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of the Executive Director of the Maine Health Care Finance Commission by the Governor.

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 7 follows:

8 Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§1, as amended by PL 9 1985, c. 785, Pt. A, §1, is further amended to read:

10 1. <u>Range 91.</u> The salaries of the following 11 state officials and employees shall be within salary 12 range 91:

the commission. The executive director shall serve at the pleasure of the commission <u>Governor</u> and his salary shall be set by the commission <u>Governor</u> within the range established by Title 2, section 6-B 6. The executive director shall appoint a deputy director, who shall perform the duties delegated to him by the executive director. The deputy director shall serve at the pleasure of the executive director and his salary shall be set by the executive director within the range established by Title 2, section 6. The commission may employ such other staff as it deems necessary. The appointment and compensation of such other staff shall be subject to the Civil Service Law.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is to provide that the 16 Executive Director of the Maine Health Care Finance 17 Commission is appointed by the Governor rather than 18 by the commission.
