AN ACT to Require the Department of Human
Services to Establish a So-called
"Fair Rental" Methodology for
Reimbursement of Capital Costs for
Nursing Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §1708, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 365, §1, is amended to read:

2. Compensation for nursing homes. A nursing home, as defined under section 1812-A, or any portion of a hospital or institution operated as a nursing home. When the State is lightly for neurons for some

called "fair rental" methodology similar to that utilized in certain other states, which bases reimbursement on a fair market appraisal of the particular facility as opposed to historical costs.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill would require the Department of Human Services to implement a so-called "fair rental" methodology for reimbursement of capital costs for nursing homes. The states of Maryland and California, among others, have implemented similar proposals.

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
