9 10 11 12	A "small claim" means a right of action cognizable by a court if the debt or damage does not exceed \$1,400 \$2,500 exclusive of interest and costs. It shall not include an action involving the title to

The purpose of this bill increases the small claims court limit from \$1,400 to \$2,500. This will enable consumers and businesses greater access to this court for quicker resolution of disputes involving relatively small dollar amounts without the need to hire an attorney.

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
