AN ACT Concerning Snowmobile
Registration Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§2, as enacted by PL
1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

2. Fee. The annual snowmobile registration fee
is ~~11-25~~ \$15 after the effective date of this Act;
\$16 after July 1, 1988; \$17 after July 1, 1989; and
\$18 after July 1, 1990.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§3, ¶A, as amended by
PL 1985, c. 459, Pt. C, §2, is further amended to
read:

1 A. The registration fee for residents shall be
2 credited as follows:

3 (1) \$4.75 of each fee shall be credited to
4 the department;

5 (2) ~~50¢~~ \$4.25 of each fee shall be credited
6 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Bureau
7 of Parks and Recreation after the effective
8 date of this Act; \$5.25 after July 1, 1988;
9 \$6.25 after July 1, 1989; and \$7.25 after
10 July 1, 1990; and

11 (3) \$6 of each fee shall be annually dis-
12 tributed to the municipality of the owner's
13 residence as shown on his registration cer-
14 tificate, except that in unorganized terri-
15 tory, \$6 of each fee shall be annually dis-
16 tributed to the county of the owner's resi-
17 dence as shown on his registration certifi-
18 cate and credited to the unorganized terri-
19 tory fund of that county established in Ti-
20 tle 30, section 5902.

21 Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§3, ¶B, as amended by
22 PL 1981, c. 698, §76, is further amended to read:

23 B. The registration fee for nonresidents shall
24 be credited as follows:

25 (1) \$10.75 of each fee shall be credited to
26 the department; and

27 (2) ~~50¢~~ \$4.25 of each fee shall be credited
28 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Bureau
29 of Parks and Recreation after the effective
30 date of this Act; \$5.25 after July 1, 1988;
31 \$6.25 after July 1, 1989; and \$7.25 after
32 July 1, 1990.
