1 AN ACT to Require all Licensed Guides to have  
2 Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation First  
3 Aid Certification.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7301, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

8 11. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation requirement.  
9 All licensed guides must be certified in  
10 cardiopulmonary resuscitation first aid. This certi-  
11 fication must be renewed every 3 years.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The present law requires licensed guides to be cardiopulmonary resuscitation certified if they received their licenses subsequent to 1980. This bill requires all guides to be certified.
