COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 182, L.D. 226,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Immunization of  
Post-secondary Students."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after  
the enacting clause and before the statement of fact  
and inserting in its place the following:

'20-A MRSA §6359, sub-§1, ¶H, as enacted by PL  
1985, c. 771, §§2 and 7, is repealed and the follow-  
ing enacted in its place:

H. "Student" means any person born after 1956  
who attends school full time or who is a candi-  
date for a degree, diploma or graduate certifi-  
cate.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill. It  
limits the immunization requirement for  
post-secondary students to those attending school  
full time or who are candidates for a degree, diploma  
or graduate certificate.
