IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to Immunization of
Post-secondary Students.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

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20-A MRSA §6359, sub-§1, ¶H, as enacted by PL
1985, c. 771, §§2 and 7, is amended to read:

H. "Student" means any person entering school
enrolled in a full-time instructional program in
either the fall or spring semester who was born
after 1956.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to amend the defini-
3 tion of "student" so that part-time or summer stu-
4 dents, or those participating in conferences at
5 post-secondary institutions, are not subject to the
6 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 6359.

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
