4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 20-A MRSA §5201, sub-§2, ¶¶A and B, as enacted by
7 PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, are amended to read:

8 A. A person who will be at least 6 years old on
9 ~~October 15th of the~~ or before May 1st of the
10 preceding school year may enroll in grade one.

11 B. A person who will be at least 5 years old on
12 ~~October 15th of the~~ or before May 1st of the
13 preceding school year may enroll in a one-year
14 kindergarten if it is offered.
