STATE OF MAINE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN
AN ACT Relating to Use of 6-axle Vehicles to Haul Commodities.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
29 MRSA §1655, as amended by PL 1985, c. 812, Pt. A, §§4 and 5, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
A 6-axle combination vehicle, as defined in sec- tion 1652, subsection 1, paragraph E, may be issued the special commodity permit to the gross weights al- lowed that vehicle without regard for the commodity carried.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 Current law allows haulers of hundreds of commod-3 ities to use the 6-axle vehicle as proposed by the 4 Department of Transportation. Haulers of these com-5 modities will be able to take advantage of these 6 loads being allowed in New Hampshire, Massachusetts, 7 Rhode Island and Canada. Those not currently included 8 would not be included without this bill.
